The providers listed above were solicited by constituents of Affinity Community Services and the larger Black lesbian and bisexual women's community. Constituents were asked to refer both primary and behavioral health care providers with they had positive experiences in terms of actual care, office environment, partner inclusion in treatment, and inclusive language on all forms and documents.

The decision to survey our constituency and provide a provider resource guide was built on the Take Charge Study (2001) conducted by Affinity and the University of Chicago, which surveyed more than 250 of our constituents to determine quality of life indicators across multiple life domains. One of the major findings from this study was the need to have greater access to competent and sensitive providers. As a result, the Affinity Health Committee began a process in 2005 of developing a survey, recruiting constituents to provide input and recommendations, and ultimately interviewing providers for inclusion, which was completed in February of 2008.

Our hope is that the web listing will be updated annually and expanded in numbers and across areas of care through constituency referrals. We thank the initial providers listed for their willingness to be included, and expect that this attempt to connect women with competent providers will result in improved levels of care and wellness for women and impact larger healthcare systems.
